



Appendix to Constitution & Procedural Rules

Reserve League Rules

(amended January 2012)

1. **Entry fee shall be £15 per team.**
2. **Matches to start at 8:30pm.**
3. **Teams shall consist of 3 or more players.**
4. **A match shall consist of 3 sets of 4 frames making 12 frames in the match. Players may play a maximum of four times in any one match, once in each set and can only break a maximum of three times in any one match.**
5. **A point will be awarded for each frame won.**
6. **A minimum of two players constitutes a team for a competitive match to take place.**
7. **A reserve team should play short handed to enable their first team to field a complete team. An individual is not allowed to compete in a Reserve league match and an SLKPA proper competitive match on the same night. Teams (first and reserve) who fall foul of these rules will be penalised.**
8. **A team failing to attend a match will result in a 12-0 defeat for the offenders and a 9-0 win credited to the non offenders. There will be no mandatory penalty imposed.**
9. **Reserve teams have no powers or votes in any matters concerning the SLKPA proper.**
10. **Reserve teams will be expected to uphold the Constitution & Procedural Rules of the SLKPA unless there are specific rules applying to the reserve league only.**
11. **The champions will receive a single perpetual trophy.**
12. **The season will commence at a suitable time after the regular SLKPA season starts.**
13. **Players do not need to be SLKPA registered to participate in matches.**
14. **Reserve teams are not compelled to attend league meetings, but may do so if they wish.**
15. **Players without an active SLKPA registration number may play in the individual knock outs providing they can supply proof that they have played the minimum amount of frames required via completed match result sheets.**
